help first-year UL Lafayette students transition successfully from high school to University life and academic work. This course is mandatory for graduation. Your student is likely already registered in a UNIV 100 section. The course has two components:

- Cajun Connection, Thursday, August 22, 2019, is an extended introduction to UL Lafayette, the campus community, and University-level work.
- 2. First-Year Seminar continues for the rest of the semester.

Cajun Connection provides your student with many opportunities to get involved in campus activities and to engage with others in the Ragin' Cajun community with similar interests. Cajun Connection is officially the first day of class for freshmen. Attendance is mandatory. This means arriving on time, and being fully prepared with a book bag, writing utensils, and a notebook.

Check-in begins at 9:30 a.m. in the Quad where students will take the class picture. Students will be able to confirm their Cajun Connection classroom location at check-in. Class starts promptly at II:00 a.m.

 Every incoming freshman should have their student I.D. on them at all times.
 This is how we will check attendance.

What to bring

- All students should arrive to class ready with necessary supplies such as writing utensils and paper.
- Certain portions of Cajun Connection will be outside so it is important to come prepared for summer conditions (August in Louisiana).
- Comfortable shoes to walk in, a water bottle, sun screen, sun glasses, some sort of hat, and an umbrella.

## HOW TO'S Cajun Connection

#### **Parking & Dining for Cajun Connection**

Cajun Connection is taking place on UL Lafayette's main campus. On campus residents will park in

residential parking lots. Commuter students will park at Cajun Field and be bused to campus. Buses will begin service at 7:00 a.m. and will run about every 20 minutes. As we expect to transport roughly I,500 commuter students, there will inevitably be some extent of wait time. Class attendance is taken promptly at 9:30 a.m., but we encourage students to arrive early! On-campus parking is also available to commuter students in the Girard Park Circle Parking Garage. A box lunch will be provided at Cajun Connection.

A note on buying textbooks: Students should wait until the first week of classes to buy books—professors will go over the syllabus on the first day of class to cover textbook information. Not all textbooks are required or specified on the syllabus. Some ways to save money include renting textbooks from the <a href="Ragin' Cajuns Store">Ragin' Cajuns Store</a> on campus, buying or renting books online, buying used books, or sometimes checking-out textbooks (for a limited time) from the campus library.

#### Freshman Week

<u>Freshman Week</u> is a fun time to get to know other students! Freshman Week begins on Sunday, August 18, and ends Sunday, August 25, 2019. See the next page for the week's schedule.

Students will get a passport at the first Info Session they attend during Freshman Week. They will get their passport stamped at every Info Session they attend , then turn it in to their Peer Mentor during Cajun Connection on Thursday, August 22. Every Info Session your student attends, they will be entered into a drawing for great prizes!

First-Year Info Sessions include "Money Management 101," "Major Conversation: How do you fit in?," "How to Master Math in Your First-Year" and more! Info Sessions begin Monday, August 19, through Wednesday, August 21, 2019.

## **New Student Convocation 2019**


