  - ◊ Grant aid (if eligible)
- Computer Lab Usage (NEW iMacs and Dell PCs)

### How do students qualify for the SSS programs?

They must meet **ONE** of these requirements:

- Have financial need
- First-Generation college student
- Student with a disability
- U.S. military veteran

### SSS programs have experts offering specialized assistance:

1. SSS [Regular](#) for all majors
2. SSS [STEM](#) for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math majors
3. SSS [Teacher Prep](#) for Education majors
4. SSS [Veterans](#) for U.S. Veterans
5. SSS [Disability](#) for students with a documented disability

Other TRIO programs in DeClouet Hall help students who are at the **pre-college level** ([Upward Bound](#), [Upward Bound Math/Science](#) and [Educational Talent Search](#)), **adults** who want to enroll in college ([Veterans Upward Bound](#)), and college students who aspire to attend **graduate school** ([LS-LAMP](#) and [McNair](#)).

#### DUAL ENROLLMENT CREDIT

UL Lafayette awards credit for college courses completed while enrolled in high school. College credit cannot be awarded based on a high school transcript. The student must send an official college transcript to receive University credit.
