
What academic treasures can be discovered in DeClouet Hall?

How do students qualify for the SSS programs?

They must meet **ONE** of theses requirements:

- Have financial need
- First-Generation college student
- Student with a disability
- U.S. military veteran

SSS programs have experts offering specialized assistance:

- 1. SSS Regular for all majors
- 2. SSS <u>STEM</u> for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math majors
- 3. SSS <u>Teacher Prep</u> for Education majors
- 4. SSS Veterans for U.S. Veterans
- 5. SSS <u>Disability</u> for students with a documented disability

Other TRIO programs in DeClouet Hall help students who are at the

pre-college level (<u>Upward Bound</u>, <u>Upward Bound Math/Science</u> and <u>Educational Talent Search</u>), adults who want to enroll in college (<u>Veterans Upward Bound</u>), and college students who aspire to attend graduate school (<u>LS-LAMP</u> and <u>McNair</u>).

#### **DUAL ENROLLMENT CREDIT**

UL Lafayette awards credit for college courses completed while enrolled in high school. College credit cannot be awarded based on a high school transcript. The student must send an official college transcript to receive University credit.

#### **ADVANCE CREDIT EXAM**
