The goal of SSS is to increase students' academic standing, college retention, and graduation rates. SSS helps students make the transition from high school to college and beyond. SSS programs are federally funded TRIO programs through the U. S. Department of Education and are within the Department of Special Services at UL Lafayette. What does SSS provide?

- **Free opportunities for academic development**
 - Tutoring (no appointment necessary)
 - Academic, financial, and career counseling
- **Motivation toward successful degree completion**
- **Financial Aid help including:**
 - [FAFSA](#) application questions and problem-solving
 - Grant aid (if eligible)
- **Computer lab usage**
- **Test Prep Materials (GRE, GMAT, etc.) and other academic resources**

HOW TO'S DeClouet Hall

To qualify for the SSS program, students must meet ONE of the following requirements:

- Have financial need
- First-Generation college student
- Student with a disability
- U.S. military veteran



SSS program experts offer specialized assistance in the following areas:

- [SSS Teacher Prep](#) for Education majors
