Course: UNIV 100 – Section 044 **Theme:** Leadership & Engagement

Course Topic: *Black Male Leadership*

Description: This course focuses on leadership as defined by and for males in the Black community. Topics will include differing definitions of “manhood,” expectations of black men (both within and outside of the black community), opinions of racial profiling, cross-generational differences, and more. We’ll look at role models for black men and discuss contemporary issues such as health awareness and disparities among black male populations, entrepreneurship, and financial literacy. Additionally, we’ll discuss interpersonal and political issues, including political activism, domestic violence, and respect towards women. Students in this course will engage in community service.
